Disable Activation Lock (Find My iPad)

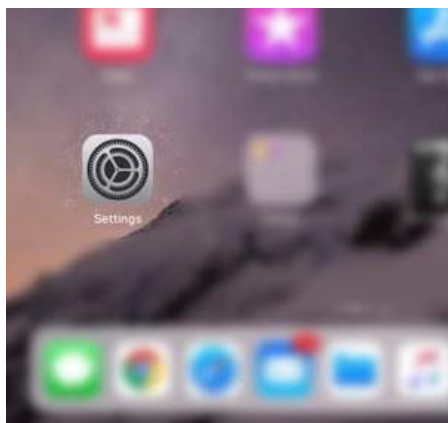
Activation Lock is Apples iOS method of theft prevention. This is provided as part of the Apple ID/iCloud service that usually gets enabled by default when signing in with an iCloud or an Apple ID. The iCloud activation lock will prevent unauthorized users from taking, wiping, and restoring your iPad without access to the Apple ID that is associated with the device.

For an BYOD (Bring Your Own Device) iPad to be enrolled at Swanbourne Primary School, the Find My iPad service needs to temporarily be disabled as it will prevent the initial device enrollment. The steps below outline the process required to disable it from the iOS device itself.

Please Note: – Due to different natures of iOS variants some of the procedure might slightly vary depending on the iOS version.

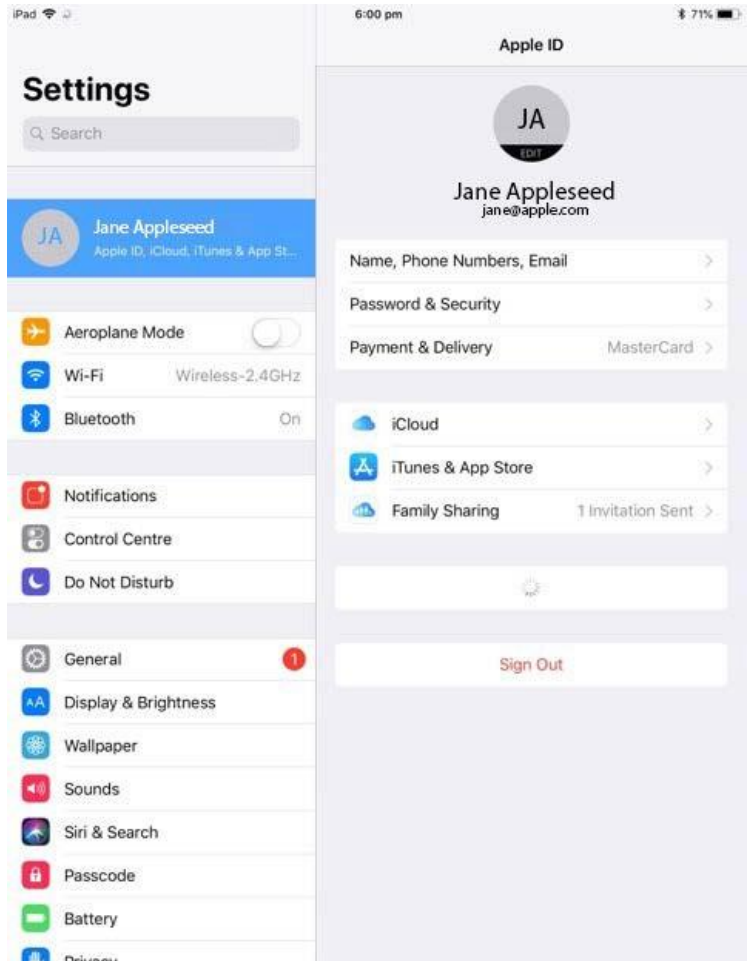
Disable Activation Lock (Find My iPad)

Turn on the iPad if it isn't already, then navigating to the **Settings** App on the Home Screen.

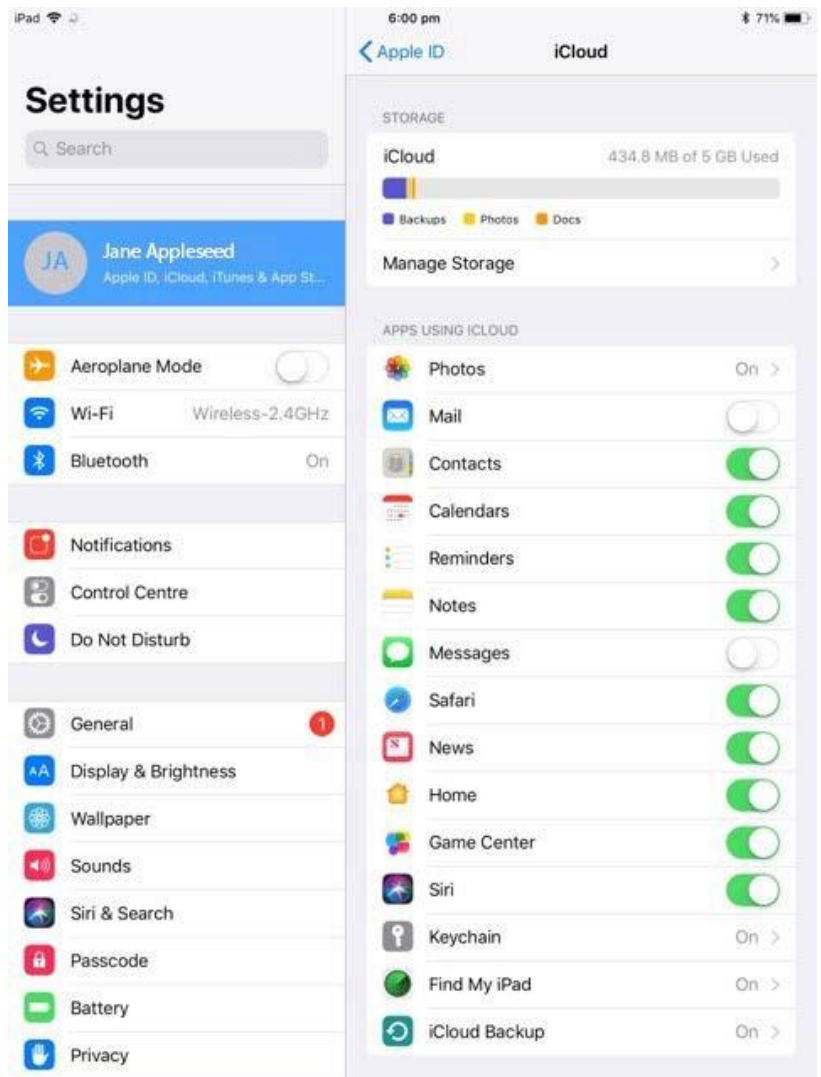


Click the users name at the top left hand side of the screen, this should be the name that is associated with the Apple ID on the account

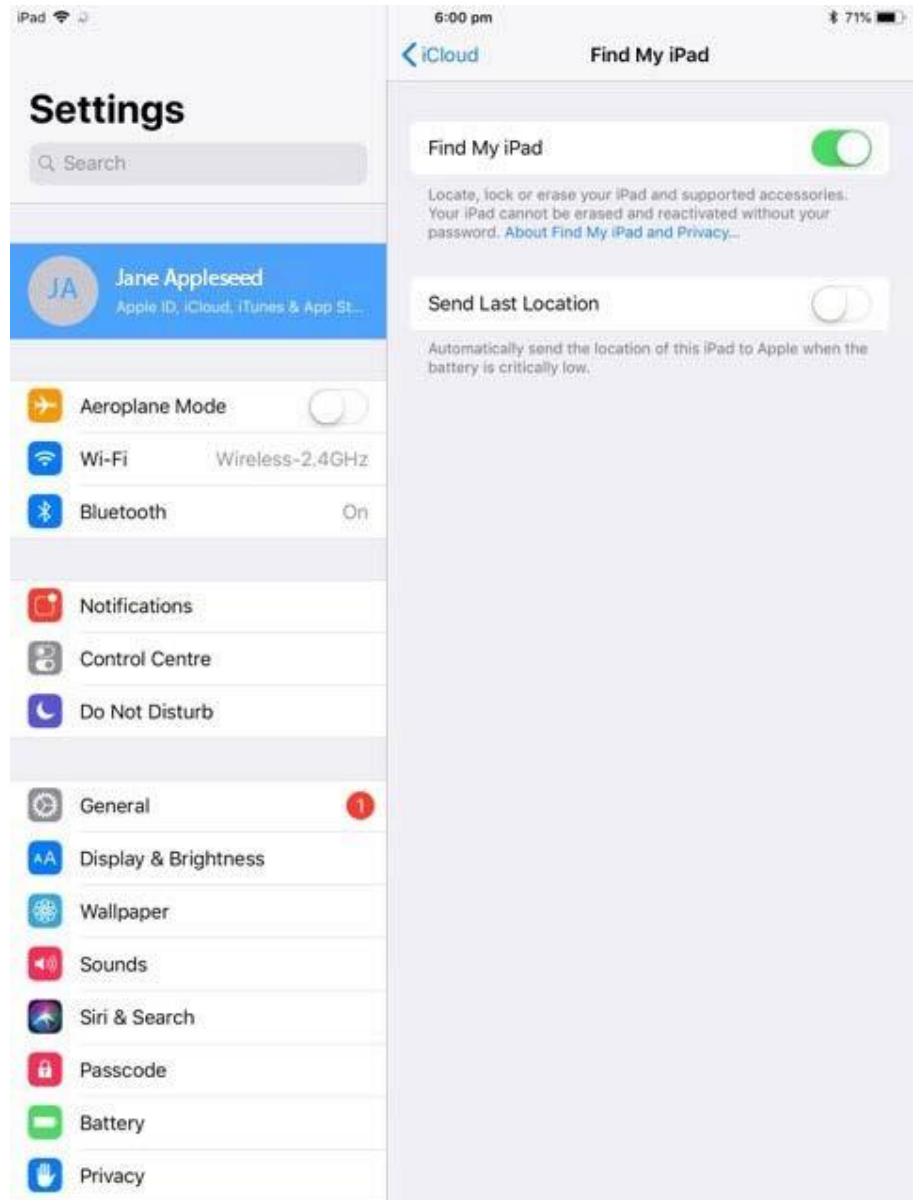
Locate and tap on **iCloud**.



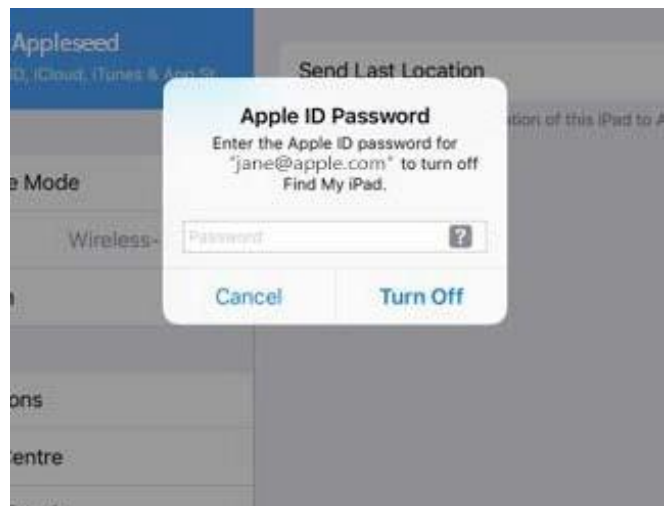
Tap **Find My iPad**.



Switch Find My iPad to Off



Enter your Apple ID password to confirm.



Tap **TURN OFF**, the process is then complete.
